Personnel who are in excess of assigned billets in the engineering or reactor departments of a nuclear powered warship or repair department of a nuclear-repair-capable submarine tender or staff of a nuclear pipeline training activity, or assigned to a Department of Energy Naval Reactors facility are entitled to the appropriate level of SDAP.</p> <p>b. Sailors holding 3359/3389 NEC may receive SDAP while performing duties as assigned in the nuclear propulsion program. Specific approval must be obtained from the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations (N133D) for the member to be eligible and will be started and stopped by N133D.
