Subj: CONFINEMENT PARAMETERS AND TRANSFER GUIDELINES FOR FEMALE PRISONERS

Ref: (a) NAVPERS 15560D (Naval Military Personnel Manual (MILPERSMAN))
(b) NPC ltr 1640 Ser 00D1/031 of 13 Mar 09 (Subj: Post-trial Confinement Parameters)

1. Purpose. To identify Navy shore confinement facilities authorized to confine female servicemembers and their post-trial confinement parameters.

2. Confinement Facilities. Per article 1640-030 of reference (a), the following shore confinement facilities are authorized to confine female servicemembers in a pretrial status:

a. Naval Consolidated Brig Charleston Detachment (NAVCONBRIG Charleston DET) Jacksonville (JAX)

b. Naval Brig (NAVBRIG) Norfolk

d. NAVCONBRIG Miramar

c. NAVCONBRIG Miramar DET Puget Sound

e. NAVCONBRIG Miramar DET Pearl Harbor

3. Post-trial Confinement Parameters

a. Per reference (b), post-trial confinement at NAVCONBRIG Charleston DET JAX for male and female service members is limited to an adjusted sentence (court-ordered sentence minus administrative/judicial credit, good conduct time, etc.) of 30 days or less.

b. Per article 1640-030 of reference (a), post-trial confinement at NAVBRIG Norfolk for male and female servicemembers is limited to an adjudged sentence of up to one year.

c. Per article 1640-030 of reference (a), post-trial confinement at NAVCONBRIG Miramar for female servicemembers is authorized for Level I through III sentences.

d. Per article 1640-030 of reference (a), post-trial confinement at NAVCONBRIG Miramar DET Puget Sound and Pearl Harbor for male and female servicemembers is limited to an adjusted sentence (court-ordered sentence minus administrative/judicial credit, good conduct time, etc.) of six months or less.

4. Transfer Guidelines. All requests for transfers of female prisoners shall be routed through PERS-00D. The following guidelines apply:

a. All female prisoners assigned to Navy Region Japan awarded a court-martial sentence that includes confinement for 30 days or longer shall be confined at NAVCONBRIG Miramar.

b. All female prisoners awarded a court-martial sentence that includes confinement with greater than six months remaining on their sentence shall be confined at NAVCONBRIG Miramar or NAVBRIG Norfolk, as applicable.

c. All female prisoners awarded a court-martial sentence that includes confinement with one year or greater shall be confined at NAVCONBRIG Miramar. This does not apply to female prisoners authorized for transfer to the Federal Bureau of Prisons (FBOP).

d. All female prisoners who have any specific treatment needs including, but not limited to, offense-specific treatment or any psychiatric needs shall be considered for transfer to NAVCONBRIG Miramar after consultation with the Clinical Services Director at NAVCONBRIG Miramar.

e. All exceptions to these guidelines shall be routed through PERS-00D.
