## OPNAV NOTICE 5400

Subj: MODIFICATION OF COMMANDER, NAVAL SURFACE GROUP MIDDLE PACIFIC (COMNAVSURFGRU MIDPAC)

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44 of 5 Oct 07  
(b) OPNAVNOTE 5400 of 15 Mar 10

1. Purpose. To approve modification of subject Fleet activity per reference (a).
2. Background. By this action CNO establishes a mission statement for Commander, Naval Surface Group, Middle Pacific (COMNAVSURFGRU MIDPAC). Commander, Naval Surface Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMNAVSURFPAC) will issue a Mission, Functions, and Tasks directive per OPNAVINST 5400.44 based on newly established mission.
3. Organizational Change. Effective immediately, the following applies:
  - a. Mission Statement: To serve as the Naval Surface Group Commander to lead and manage the overall warfighting capability of the Surface Combatant Force homeported at Pearl Harbor, HI; to coordinate through the Fleet Response Plan (FRP) cycle the manning, operations, combat systems, engineering, maintenance, training, logistics, administration, and support of assigned units to achieve the highest levels of combat readiness; to coordinate with external organizations for products and services to directly support Surface Combatant Force mission readiness; and to support the Type Commanders and Numbered Fleet Commanders in the development of Surface Warfare requirements, policies, programs, standards, and business practices to meet operational readiness goals.
